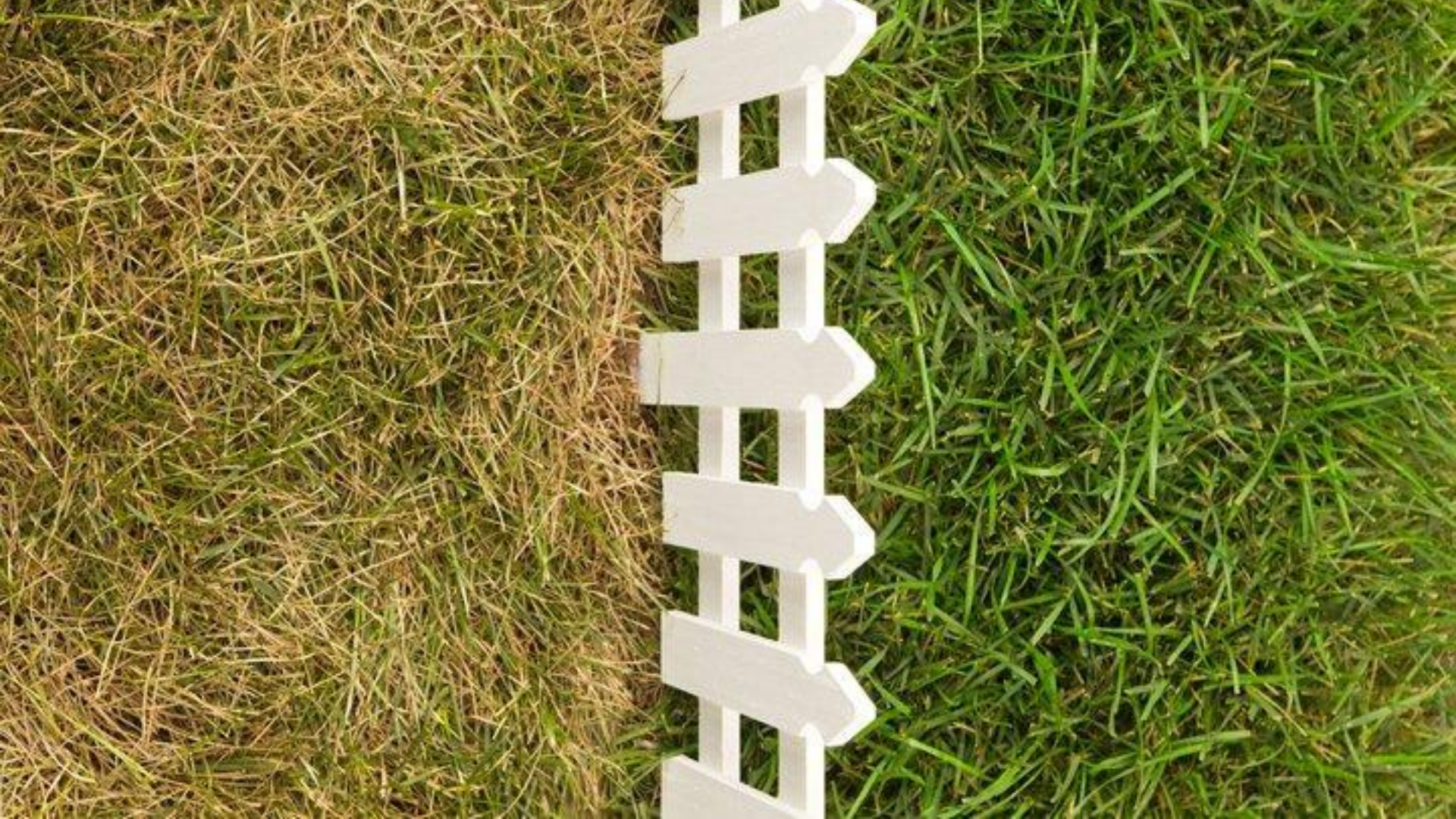

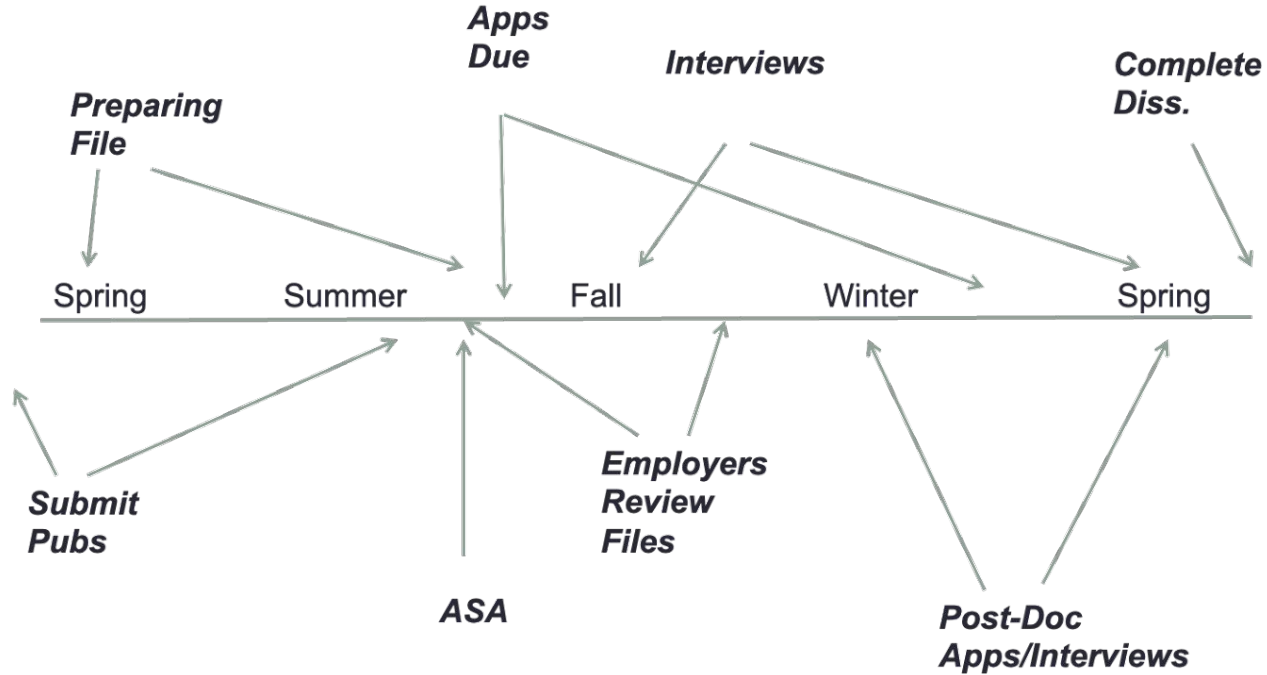

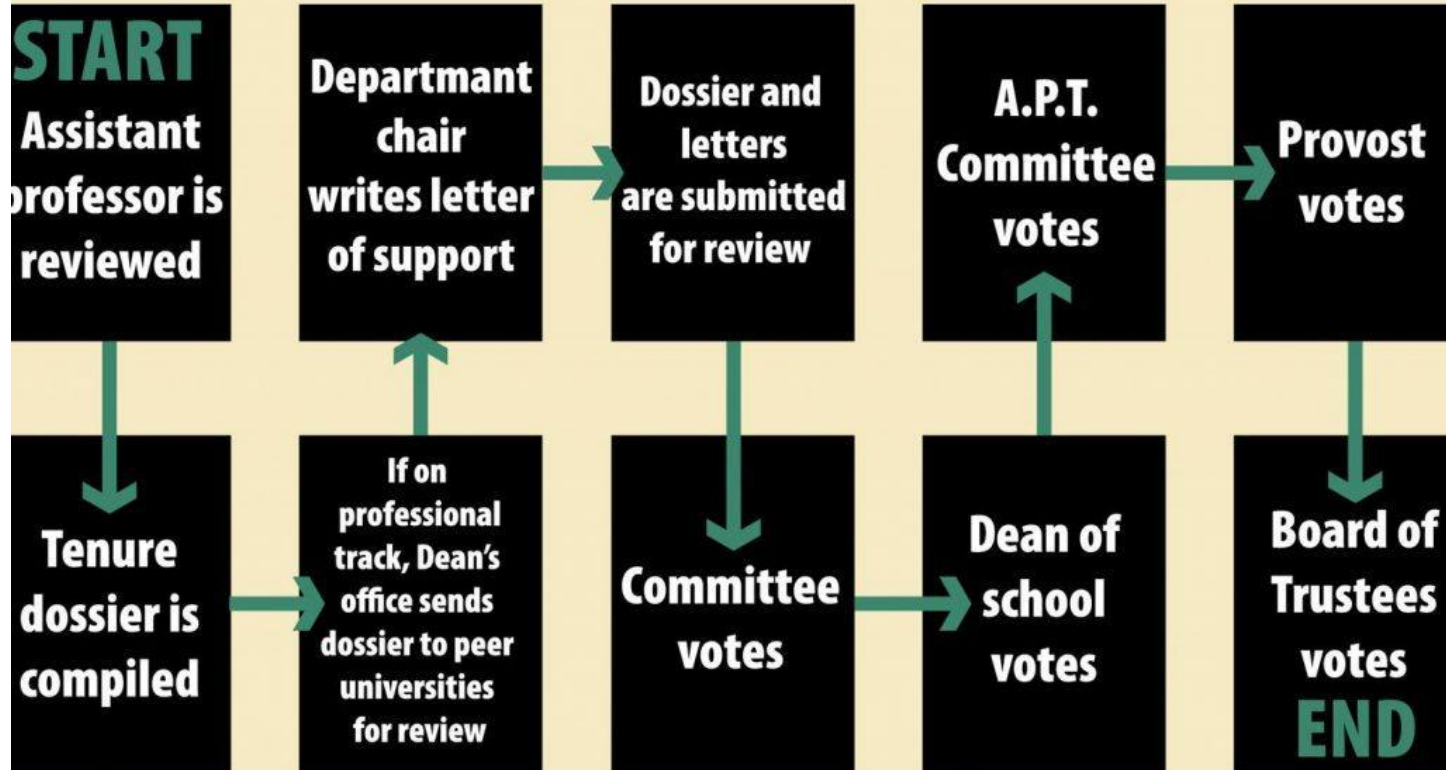
Timeline for Academic Positions
